For 20 years, residents of Willowdale and the surrounding area could enjoy Canada Day festivities including fireworks at Mel Lastman Square. This budget was removed without consultation with the community. Families with young children cannot easily travel downtown or distant locations and return home at a reasonable time.

As a child of immigrants, Canada Day celebrations were an important part of our participation in our community and celebrating our identity as Canadians. As a community with 74,000 residents whose mother tongue is neither English nor French, celebrating what we share is an important aspect of building connectivity and social fabric.
